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### President's Report,

At our 20th anniversary last year I acknowledged with gratitude the help our club, and numerous other not-for-profit and charitable organisations in our shire, have received from the Cronulla office of our Prime Minister- Scott Morrison. Since I became president of our club, we have saved over \$10,000 getting our newsletter printed for free and have received over \$7,000 participating in the Cronulla Community Classic.

Our guest speaker last month was Pam Collocott from Clever Care Now, her organisation was formally known as Nurses On Wheels and had operated for over 60 years, home nursing is still their core business. Their website is [www.clevercarenow.org.au](http://www.clevercarenow.org.au), and their phone number is 9502 3422. There are currently 19 nurses on the road, helping individuals, parents and grandparents, they also do flu vaccinations for businesses as well as pre and post-operative care.

They are available 7 days a week and have expanded into other areas such as the child literacy programme for 3-6 year olds, and a day tripper programme where a bus can pick you up to go on a social outing with lunch included for \$35, they are also an accredited NDIS service provider.

Their home nursing programme provides assistance with wound care, medication, injections, blood pressure and blood sugar checks, pharmacy collection and much more.

- being told you are owed a refund
- being told you have unpaid bills, unpaid fines from the police or a government department
- being notified there is a problem with your email or bank account
- being asked for urgent help
- being congratulated on winning a competition (you didn't enter)
- being asked to click on a link or open a document
- being sent an unexpected invoice to open
- receiving a critical alert message with a link to click
- receiving a tracking number and link for a delivery (you didn't order)
