Peter Day, our secretary, gave a short talk about a phone scam where you get a call on your mobile phone but it only rings once and you get a missed call notification, if you ring back the caller will try to maintain a conversation. Peter checked the number as to its country of origin, it was Slovenia. The longer the call lasts the more money they can make from you.

Allen Tsang from 123INKJETS gave a detailed talk about printers. There are 3 main types - inkjet, laser and photo and come under 3 categories - home, office and technology use. There are some special variations such as double-sided printers, others that can handle different size pages or use wireless or Bluetooth. Physical size can vary many are large and bulky but there is a growing number of compact models. Connectivity can be via cable, USB, ethernet, wi-fi, or NFC [near field communication]. Laser printers are better for text and are cheaper to run but are no good for photos. Inkjets are good for color printing and photos.

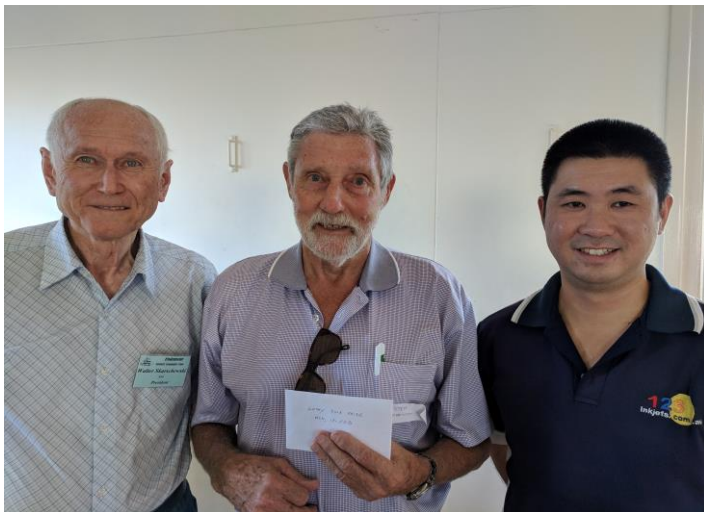

Be warned – an international mobile phone scam from Peter Day

The other week we received two missed call notifications on our mobile phones. Looking at the message showed that the call originated in Slovenia (country code +386). We published the same scam in the September newsletter but, on that occasion, the country code was Latvia (+371). The scammers will ring once and hang up leaving a missed call notification on your phone. The scammers are hoping you ring them back. If you do, they try to keep you on the line for as long as they can. Your phone call bill goes up and they pocket money from you. This is the second time I've seen this scam so be aware.
